Awareness program about HIV-AIDS

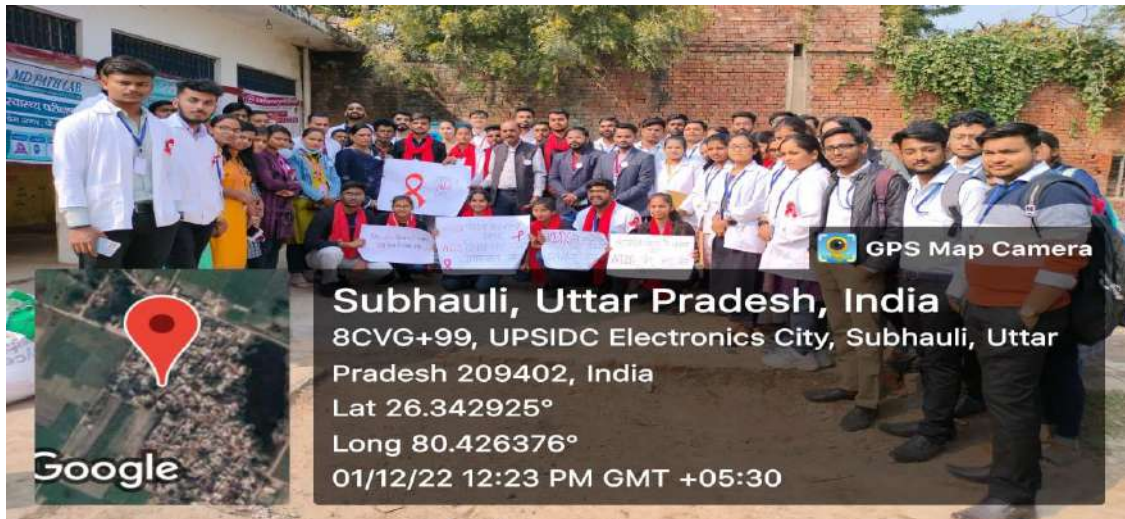


Vaccination Programme
