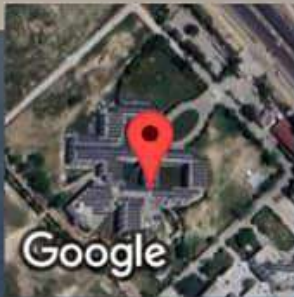




Health Awareness Program

Swachhta Pakhwada

Kanpur Institute of Technology's Environment Club and Social Club joined hands to organise a special Swachhta Pakhwada (Cleanliness Fortnight) with the subject "*We Want Evolution, Not More Plastic Pollution*" with a view to raising public awareness of the need for environmental protection, sustainable living, and the value of keeping our environment clean.

The primary ceremony, the Swachhta Pledge, was held on campus on September 14, 2023.
