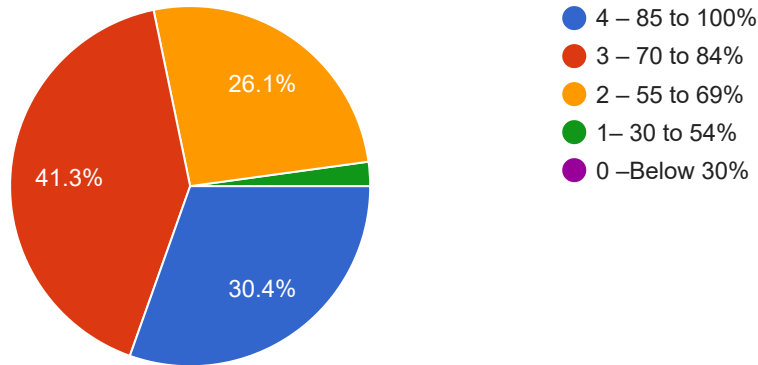

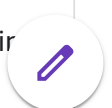
1. Firstly, interact with each students during lecture if possible.
